

Anglian Chauffeur Service has curated eight driving routes around Great Britain named THE GREAT 8. Ranging from 300 to 700 miles in length, these routes have been chosen for their breathtaking scenery and proximity to natural features, attractions and the Small & Medium Sized Enterprises (SMEs) that build and support the local and national economies.

THE GREAT 8 have been utilised to raise funds for the various regional Air Ambulances.

We have also mapped The World's Longest Coastal Touring Route, an epic 5000 miles around the Coast of Great Britain. We have named this CIRCA NAUTICA.

CIRCA NAUTICA has previously seen charity motorcycle journeys, completing in 31 days during which 172 RNLI Lifeboat Stations were visited raising funds for The Charity That Saves Lives At Sea.

CIRCA NAUTICA

CIRCA NAUTICA has been appraised as The World's Longest Coastal Touring Route, a complete circumnavigation of Great Britain's coastline by road. As the largest island in continental Europe, we are blessed with incredible diversity in coastal geology, geography and culture.

From the chalky Sussex Downs and the White Cliffs of Dover to the man-made landscapes on the East and West of Norfolk. The windswept Scottish Highlands gives way to the undulating tranquility of the English Lake District.

The route through Wales encompasses the eclectic charm of Portmeirion. From Exmoor and round the Cornish coastline brings the traveler back to Sussex, energized and invigorated from experiencing the rich beauty and epic scale of this island's diversity.

THE GREAT 8 (GR88)


We have planned eight routes the length and breadth of Great Britain that roughly follow a figure of 8, a double-loop encompassing miles of remarkable landscapes, idyllic communities and hidden gems of history and culture. The GREAT 8 (GR88) have been specifically designed for touring in mind. The aim is that a route will take 7 to 14 days and being constructed in the two loops these can be done as separate circular routes which take 3 to 4 days, providing a long weekend or mid-week getaway.

It is hoped that these routes will inspire people to travel through Great Britain, exploring and discovering as an educational resource to better understanding the country in which we live and work.

BRITAIN IS OPEN

Now that the Corornavirus Covid-19 Lockdown Restrictions have been lifted, Britain is again Open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year.





THE GREAT 8 COTSWOLDS & CHILTERNS

The rolling Cotswold escarpment hills provide vistas on every turn of the classic rural lanes. Through the flatter, leafy Thames Valley, rising once more into the Chiltern Hills. The landscape between is wide hilltop views. Rural Northamptonshire provides the link between the Cotswolds and Chilterns, a peaceful county rich in rural farmland.

Discover the ornate Maharajah's Well in Stoke Row an amazing gift from an Indian Prince. A standard 4 feet in diameter, dug by hand mostly through chalk, but is deeper that the height of two Nelson's columns.


THE GREAT 8 EAST of ENGLAND

Protruding into the North Sea, the furthest point East on mainland Great Britain and nothing comes between it and the North Pole. Norfolk is one of the most constant changing landscapes in Great Britain. The Broads which is now water used to be land and The Fens which is now land used to be water. The Deep History Coast evidencing 800,000 years of habitation couples well with a visit to Grimes Graves, a Neolithic Flint Mine.

Discover the history of The Energy Industry with a visit to Fakenham Museum of Gas & Local History. The River Wensum which flows through Fakenham is the most protected Chalk Bed River in Europe, a SSSI Site for its entire length and see how the mills used the river to work in unison.



THE GREAT 8 LANCASHIRE & YORSHIRE

Atmospheric romantic ruins in a vast heather clad moorland landscape. Winding roads stretch through the river valleys and glorious dales contrasting the exposed and desolate expanse of hill tops. A patchwork blanket of sheep grazing pastureland divided by drystone walls, populated by lonesome stone barns.

Discover "The Robin Hood Prince of Thieves Waterfall" in the back garden of The Green Dragon in Hardraw; the limestone pillars of The Buttertubs and get a sense of the harsh conditions travellers faced on the way to the coaching inn on Tan Hill.

THE GREAT 8 CUMBRIA & NORTHUMBERLAND


Cumbria offers driving access to wild, untamed mountainous terrain with some of the most technically challenging roads in Great Britain yet extremely rewarding to negotiate.

Northumberland is sparsely populated with a large pristine moorland landscape offering beautifully wild panoramic vistas due mainly to it being protected as part of the Northumberland National Park.


England's largest man-made lake and a scenic forest drive through the largest planted forest are enroute to Carter Bar, the most scenic of border crossings to Scotland.

THE GREAT 8 SCOTTISH SOUTHERN UPLANDS

The Southern Uplands are the southernmost and least populous of mainland Scotland's three major geographic areas where smooth, rounded, strongly dissected and steep sided hills characterise the landscape.

From the huge views of the Cheviots to the cosmic views offered by the Galloway Forest Dark Sky Park. Visit the World's Oldest Post Office in Sanquhar, opened in 1712. If you send a letter or postcard from here it is stamped with unique postmark. Discover the story of William Wallace, a Scottish Knight portrayed by Mel Gibson in the film "Braveheart".


THE GREAT 8 MOUNTAINS, LOCHS & GLENS

Featuring the Great Glen but utilizing the Old Military Road of General Wade along the Southern Shore of Loch Ness.
Surrounded by steep sided Munros, shadowing the A82 from both sides, Glencoe appears to be a dark and mysterious yet stunningly beautiful in the same instant.

The romantic Trossachs offer sparkling lochs, crumpled hills and sleepy forests.


The Cairngorm plateau is the highest, coldest and snowiest plateau in Britain, home to the most northerly Dark Sky Park in the world, and the darkest in the UK. Huge forests of ancient native trees dominate the lower landscape with wondrous waterfalls cascading through them into tranquil lochs. Out of the tree line barren mountain tops tower towards the sky.



THE GREAT 8 NORTH & MID WALES

The dramatic and rugged landscape of Snowdonia National Park, an International Dark Sky Reserve offers some staggering mountain and lakeside scenery. Long stretches of mountain road give unhindered vistas over vast swathes of countryside.

The drive around The Great Orme headland, a massive chunk of limestone rising 207m/679ft straight out of the sea gives stunning seascape vistas its name, given by the Vikings, means 'sea monster'.

From the picturesque setting of Lake Vyrnwy the road to Bala passes through a wondrous hillscapes offering huge panoramas.

The GREAT 8 SOUTH & MID WALES


Llanidloes is the geographic centre of Wales and connects the two routes through Wales, it is also the first major town on the River Servern from its source on Plynlimon, the highest point of the Cambrian Mountains and the highest point in Mid Wales. The spectacular landscape backdrop of the Brecon Beacons, an International Dark Sky Reserve, presents some of the finest scenery in South Wales.

High open mountain plateaus with smooth grassy slopes and knife edge ridges that give way to crags and wooded gorges, waterfalls and caves. Elegant Victorian Dams have created four scenic reservoirs through the Elan Valley leading to the "Wild Wales" of the Cambrian Mountains.

Venture into the wild Welsh landscape around Llyn Brianne.
